

Concetta Russo holds a Ph.D. in anthropology and is currently a sociology and social research postdoctoral fellow at the University of Milan-Bicocca. She has conducted qualitative and mixed methods studies in Cuba, Australia, and Italy, exploring precarious and informal workers' subjectivity concerning the subtle forms of power that saturate everyday life. She recently co-authored a book on participative social research techniques, with a specific focus on collaborative ethnography and visual methods. Her current research focuses on the relationship between academic precarious employment and family planning, paying specific attention to the transition to adulthood and work-family balance. She also studies health, social capital, and labor market inequalities among the elderly population in Italy.

Finally, she achieved the National Scientific qualification as Associate Professor in the Italian higher education system, in the call 2021/2023 (Ministerial Decree n. 553/2021 and 589/2021) for the disciplinary field of 14/C1 – General sociology.
